BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Why did Jesus tell stories? Jesus told stories to teach people about God.

BIBLE STORY:

PARABLE OF THE SOWER

- Jesus told a story to teach people about sharing the good news about God with others.
- The story was about a farmer planting seeds.
- Only the seeds planted in good soil grew strong and healthy.
- Jesus taught that not all people will believe in Him.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

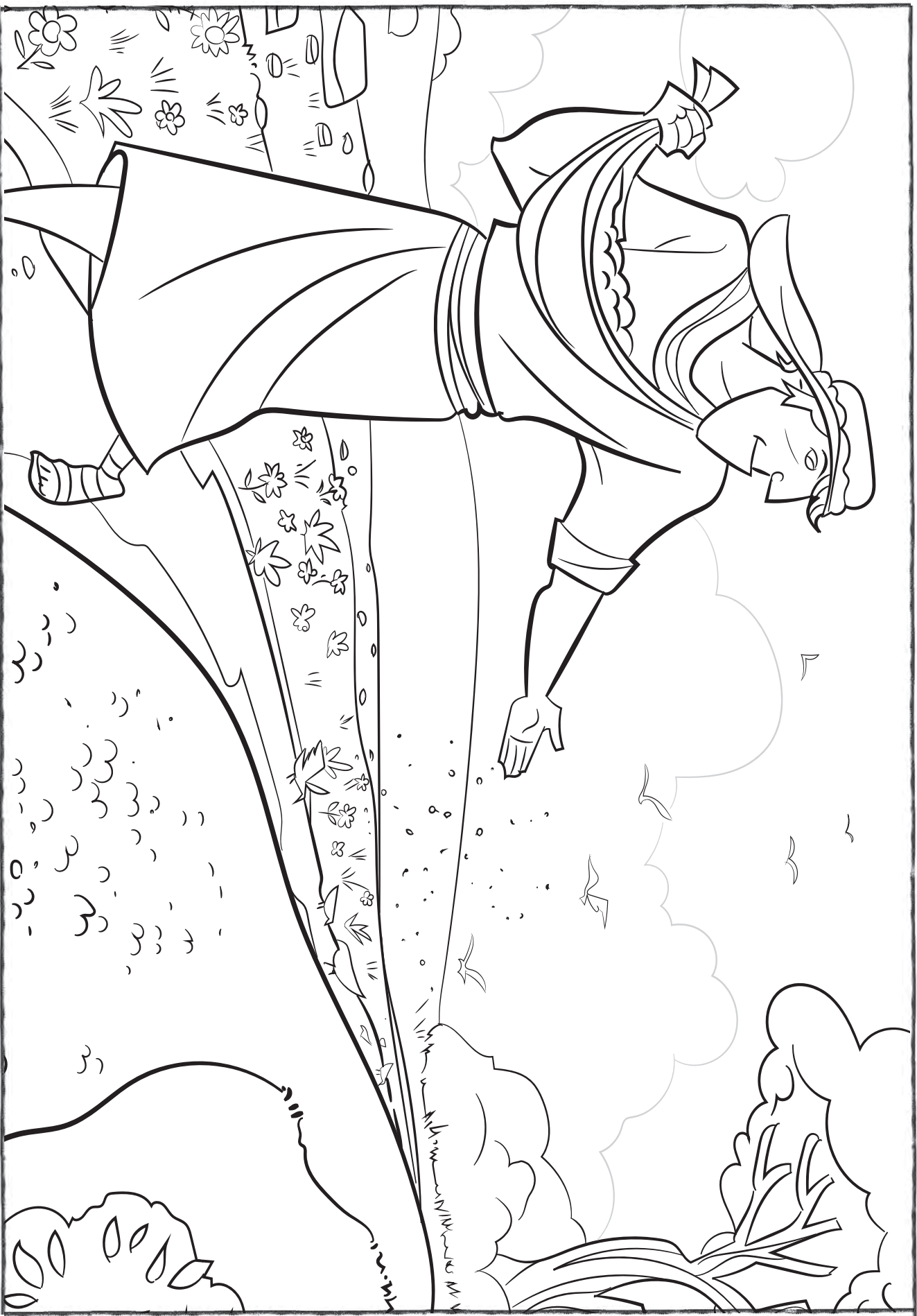
- What did the story Jesus told about the seeds really mean?
