Bible Passage: Mark 5:21-43

Key Passage: Psalm 103:2-3

Main Point: Jesus healed a woman and raised a girl from the dead.

Christ Connection: Jesus showed His power as the Messiah. He healed the woman and raised the girl from the dead. Jesus showed His power when He died on the cross and rose again to save people from sin and death. When we trust in Jesus, God forgives our sin and we will live with Him forever.

Review Questions

Whose daughter was very sick? (*Jairus*)

What did the woman do when Jesus passed by? (*touched His clothes*)

What did Jesus say healed the woman? (*her faith*)

What did Jesus do for Jairus's daughter? (*Jesus raised her from the dead.*)

What did Jesus heal people from? Jesus healed people from sickness, sin, and death.

Learn the big picture question

Say • Our big picture question is, ***What did Jesus heal people from? Jesus healed people from sickness, sin, and death.*** Jesus used His power to heal the woman and raise the girl from the dead. Jesus is God's Son. When we trust in Him, we will live with Him forever!

Practice the key passage

Open your Bible to Psalm 103:2-3. Read the key passage aloud several times.

Say • Jesus showed His power when He died on the cross and rose again to save people from sin and death. He is able to forgive all our sin; He is able to heal all our diseases. We should praise the Lord!

Activity Page

Guide preschoolers to circle the items that belong in the doctor's kit and to draw an **X** over the items that do not belong. Say • Good job deciding what belongs in the doctor's kit. In today's Bible story, a little girl and a woman were very sick, but no doctors could help them. Can you guess who was able to help them?

Pray

Say • God, thank You for hearing our prayer and caring about our requests. Thank You for loving us and sending Your Son, Jesus, to die on the cross and rise again to save us from sin and death. You are a good and loving God. Help us to trust in You. We love You. Amen.

Activities

Walk by faith

Tell preschoolers to line up on one side of the room. Place chairs, toys, and other objects on the floor to create an “obstacle” course. The first preschooler in line may wear a blindfold or close her eyes. An adult helper will lead the preschooler around the objects on the floor to the other side of the room.

Say • **Jesus healed a woman and raised a girl from the dead.** The woman and Jairus had faith that Jesus could help them. They trusted Jesus. When we trust in Jesus, He forgives our sin and we will live with Him forever.

Make a fabric collage

Gather an assortment of scrap fabric. Provide a 9-by-12-inch piece of felt for each preschooler. Use a permanent marker to write the main point on each felt piece. Invite preschoolers to feel the various fabric scraps. Allow preschoolers to use fabric glue to attach scraps of their choice to their felt to create a collage.

Say • **Jesus healed a woman and raised a girl from the dead.** The woman believed Jesus could heal her. When she reached out and touched the fabric of Jesus’ clothes, she knew she was healed! Jesus is powerful because He is the Son of God. Jesus showed His power when He died on the cross and rose again to save people from sin and death.

Touch colors

Explain to preschoolers that you will call out the word *touch* and a color. Preschoolers must run and touch something in the room that is that color. Help preschoolers find items in the room of the proper color as needed. Consider allowing preschoolers to take turns calling out colors for the group to touch.

Say • In today’s Bible story, a woman and a girl were very sick, but a touch from Jesus was all they needed to be healed. ***What did Jesus heal people from? Jesus healed people from sickness, sin, and death.***

How would you feel?

Ask preschoolers several questions and have them respond by making the appropriate facial expression. You can start with questions about themselves and then ask questions about the Bible story.

Say • Jairus was worried, then sad, then happy! **Jesus healed a woman and raised a girl from the dead.** We can praise Jesus for His awesome power!
