KEY TERMS

Worship Care: 8:30am & 11:15am childcare during the corporate worship service

Discipleship Hour: An intentional hour of discipleship between the services.

Preschool: Refers to children six weeks old through five years old (who are not yet in

kindergarten)

FAQS

What time will everything be at?

The Worship Services are at 8:30am and 11:15am. For the Discipleship Hour, check-in will begin at 10:00am and the lesson will start at 10:15am.

When can I drop off my child?

You may drop your child off in their classroom 15 minutes prior to the start of the service.

For the Discipleship Hour you may not check in until 10:00am.

Please respect these times and do not drop off your child any earlier in order to allow our volunteers to trade off between the times without any added congestion or confusion. This will help keep our children safe, ensuring sure every child is properly checked in and out.

Do the children need to be picked up between hours?

No. During the check-in process, please select all hours that you plan for your child to be in childcare. For example, select 8:30 One year olds and 10:00 One Year Olds if you plan for your child to attend both the first service and the discipleship hour. In some cases children will be moved to a new classroom between one hour to the next, but you are not expected to check them out and move them, our volunteers will do that. You can reference your child's sticker to see which room they will be in during each hour.

What will the curriculum be like in each hour?

The daily bible lesson will come from the Gospel Project. While it is the same story between Worship Care and Discipleship Hour, it will be taught differently. During Worship Care, children two years old through five years old will have a video lesson with musical worship and a corresponding activity page. During the Discipleship Hour, children three to five years old will have the same teachers every week teaching them a lesson with supporting activities.

There is no curriculum for babies-one year olds during Worship Care, and no curriculum for babies-two year olds during the Discipleship Hour.

Where do the five year olds go?

If your child is five and in kindergarten they will attend the Elementary Discipleship Hour. If your child turns five during the year, he/she will remain in Preschool Discipleship Hour. Five year olds who are not yet in kindergarten are also welcome into the four and five year old classroom during worship care. This is different from the past, in which children immediately began attending corporate worship when they turned five. We primarily made this change to help eliminate any confusion between which children can stay between Worship Care and The Discipleship Hour. However, we also recognize that being five does not equal the maturity of a kindergartener and hope this change helps better serve families whose child struggles with the transition to corporate worship. We do highly encourage you to use this time to slowly begin taking your five year old to corporate worship to help them prepare for when they enter kindergarten and begin attending corporate worship full time.

Will children be served snack?

Yes. We know some children will be in our care for two and a half hours and will be hungry. Children will receive a light snack of plain Cheerios during the Discipleship Hour. Please bring a spill proof water bottle or sippy cup of water each week. If a child does not have their own cup to drink from, we will provide them with an 8oz water bottle. If your child is allergic to one of the ingredients in Cheerios (oats, corn, sugar, salt) please let us know.
